

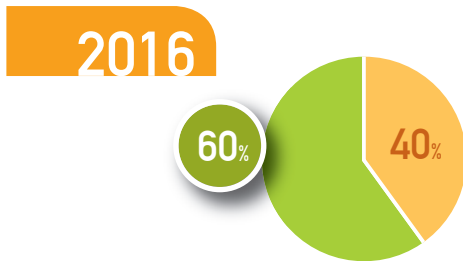
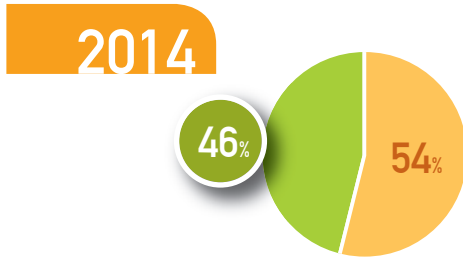

PALM OIL monitoring



The FEDIOL survey covers intake volumes of crude palm oil and fractions entering the EU refineries of FEDIOL companies participating in the survey.

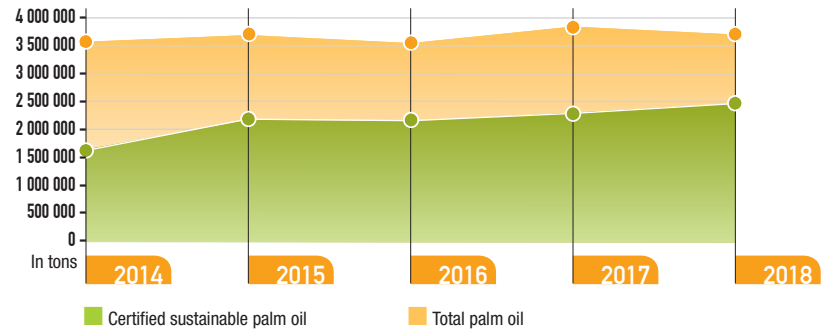
Certified sustainable palm oil intake by FEDIOL reporting companies increased from 46% to 66%

 ■ Non-certified palm oil used by FEDIOL Members

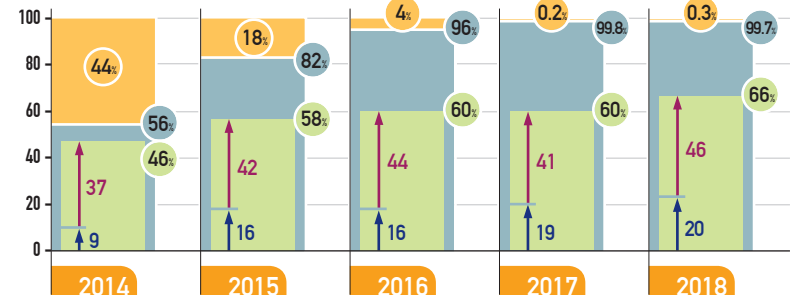


The total palm oil refined by FEDIOL members in 2018 amounted to 3.7 million tons, a decrease of 3% from 3.9 million tons in 2017. In contrast total certified sustainable palm oil volumes increased by 7%



The non-certified sustainable but traceable volumes are a means to initiate a transition to more sustainability. In 2018, 99.7% of the total intake volumes of FEDIOL companies participating in the survey were traceable (including the 66% certified sustainable), leaving virtually no oil which was neither certified sustainable nor traceable.

Percentage of intake volumes: Palm Oil



Volumes traded under mass balance increased to 20% of the total intake volume. Palm oil traded as segregated/IP increased to 46% of the total intake volume.

 ■ Mass balance

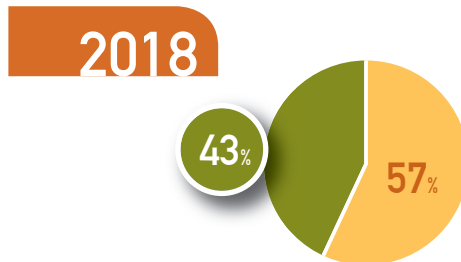
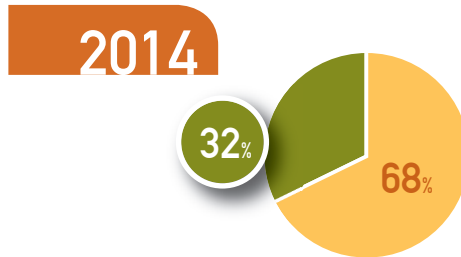

PALM KERNEL OIL monitoring



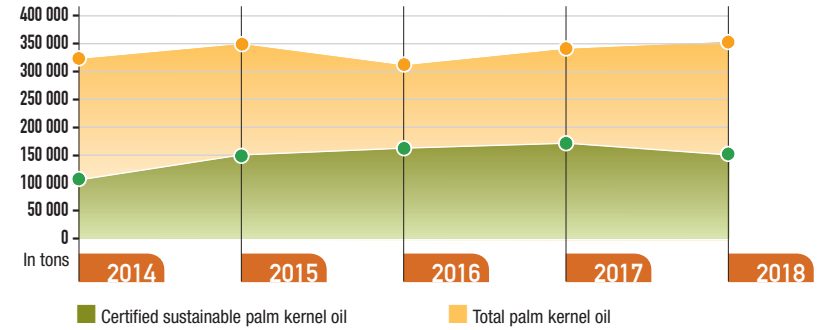
The FEDIOL survey covers intake volumes of crude palm kernel oil and fractions entering the EU refineries of FEDIOL companies participating in the survey.

Certified sustainable palm kernel oil intake by FEDIOL reporting companies increased from 32% to 52% in 2016 to decrease again to 43% in 2018.

The total volume of palm kernel oil refined by FEDIOL members in 2018 amounted to 350.000 tons compared to the certified sustainable palm kernel oil volume of 151.000 tons.



The non-certified but traceable volumes reached 99.9% of the total intake of FEDIOL companies participating in the survey in 2018 (including the certified sustainable), leaving virtually no oil which is neither certified sustainable nor traceable.
